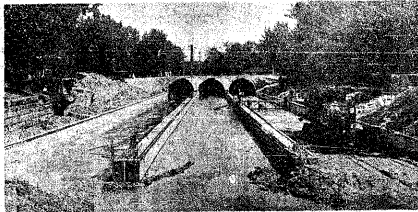

As always, there will be interesting contests for young and old. Prizes include theatre tickets and baseballs autographed by the Cleveland Indians.

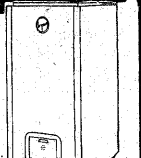
